## Frequently Asked Questions

### What do I need to do to enroll in the Detroit Compact?

- Click <http://www.detroitcollegepromise.com/DetroitCompact.pdf> to review the application.

### I am in grades 9, 10 or 11 - what do I need to do?

- You must fill out pages 4, 5, and 6 of the **Four Year program**, but please read through the whole form.
- On page 4, you only need to fill out your **Name, Address, Telephone, High School**, and the **name of your Parent/Guardian**.
- On page 5, you only need to fill out your **Name, School, Student I.D.**, and **only you** need to **sign and date**.
- On page 6 you need to print your name at the top, and **only you** need to **sign and date**.

### I am in grade 12 - what do I need to do?

- You must fill out **all pages** of the Four Year Program for the Detroit Compact.
- If you later decide you are going to attending a community college, you can switch at a later time.

### Seniors, submit these documents with your application:

- Detroit Compact Four Year Scholar Student Information
- Compact Senior Pre-Graduation Assessment
- High school Transcript
- College acceptance letter
- Copy of SAT or ACT Scores

### What do I do next (all grades)?
