Register Now for The Detroit College Promise Scholarship!

- Register now for the easiest scholarship you will ever obtain. It only takes two minutes. Visit www.DetroitCollegePromise.org, then click on **Student Login**, then **New Student**, then fill out the form and click **Save**. Our paper application is on our **Links** page, under **Flyers**.
- To receive a scholarship, you must apply by the deadline, enroll in a DPS school and live in Detroit during grades 9-12. **That's it!** There are no GPA requirements, no minimum test scores and no essays.
- Students must register by **December 1** of their 9th grade year, but we recommend that all K-8 students in DPS schools register **now**. If it is too late to register, you can still sign up on our Home Page to receive our newsletters.

What happens when I register?

- After you register, you will receive an email thanking you for registering (if you provided us with an email address). Each month, we email you and your "designated adult" our general and student newsletters. The student newsletter has information about our scholarship, other scholarships, financial aid and educational activities by other community groups.
- In 9th grade, we will present you with a scholarship certificate and letters of encouragement from President Obama, elected officials and others.
- When you are a high school senior, you need to complete some simple documents to "claim" your scholarship. We then invite you to our summer reception, give you a gift package, and provide the final details about the scholarship award, sent directly to the college / university.

How much money will I get?

- For the class of 2011, our maximum award was \$500 for 1 year at any Michigan public college or university. We plan to increase the award each year, contingent on funding. You have 10 years from graduation to use the scholarship. We also help students obtain other grants; for the 2011-12 college year, over half of our students had ALL of their tuition covered by grants; our university students received an average of \$9,500 in total grants.
